The purpose of this list is to help you through your current probate case and encourage you to set things up so you never have to do it again.



Some important things to consider when choosing books for your probate case:

- Some books are written for beginners. Others are more involved and might be too much for someone that's new to probate.
- Probate procedures vary from state to state. Terms can be similar but may not apply to someone in Texas.
- Check the copyright date. Copyright dates may not matter for a probate overview but laws change. The pandemic has also affected probate procedures and timelines. Be careful not to read something and assume it to be true.
- Your probate attorney is your best source of current probate information for your state. Make sure you run your most important questions by them.
